

Attention First-Time Homebuyers: No Money for Down Payment? No Problem!

The County of Orange Mortgage Assistance Program (MAP) provides up to \$40,000 in down payment assistance!

- Mortgage assistance up to \$40,000 for first-time homebuyers;
- Assistance is in the form of silent second mortgage loan program; principal and interest payments deferred for term of loan;
- Borrowers must qualify for and obtain first mortgage loan from a participating lender;
- Now available for properties located in County of Orange unincorporated areas or the cities of: Aliso Viejo, Brea, Cypress, Dana Point, La Palma, Laguna Beach, Laguna Hills, Laguna Woods, Los Alamitos, Placentia, Seal Beach, Stanton, and Villa Park;
- Homebuyer education is required; and
- Family income limits apply.

Example of how the downpayment assistance works:

Amount of *mortgage loan* you can afford: \$280,000 Amount of downpayment assistance: \$40,000 Purchase price of home you can afford: \$320,000

You make payments only on the mortgage loan
